

Friends of the Sisters Library Art Committee

I. Purpose:

The purpose of the FOSL Art Committee is to encourage and regulate the display of loaned art and permanent art within the Sisters Public Library.

II. Guidelines and Responsibilities

The Art Committee shall consist of at least one member representing the local art community, at least one member of the Friends of the Sisters Library, and at least one member of the library staff as appointed by the library administration.

The Art Committee shall have a chair, which may be a shared position, and a secretary. These positions will be established for one year minimum, and may be renewed at the end of that time.

The Art committee will review and approve of all art projects, whether temporary or permanent, subject to final approval by the Friends of the Sisters Library.

However, the library staff may do shows without the need of the Art Committee's approval, such as showcase display of collections, books, etc. and special displays that may be related to the library at large.

The Art Committee shall meet as required to establish and review the art exhibits scheduled throughout the year. The committee shall also meet as required to approve of any permanent art being donated or considered for purchase, whether the art is purchased outright or commissioned by the committee for a special project.

Sub committees may be formed out of these meetings designed to help in the hanging of shows, food preparation for openings, advertising, etc.
